- Mathematics
 - Relationship building is key
 - Diversity of assessment and instruction with a focus on observation and conversation
 - Change in strategies for teachers

- Positive impact on engagement, recall, grades, vocabulary, risk taking, practice, self-correction, and analysis of others' work.

 - Equity Training for staff coming soon
 - Student survey has been completed (results to be tallied)
